Session 4: June 26-28
- Registration: Forms available at Boz's Place on the LHS main floor, and on the LHS website.
- Payment: Required in full to save your child's spot. Pay via check or credit card when you turn in the registration and health form.
- Cancellation: Must be made via email or phone one week before the first day of camp in order to receive a refund. After this date there will be no refunds.
- No supervision available outside of camp hours.
- No food or snacks provided. Campers may bring a peanut-free snack from home and a water bottle.
