Orientation Q&A

Where will orientation be held?	Orientations are held in the community room at Longmont Humane Society. This room is on the southwest corner of the building, through our intake doors.
How long is orientation?	Orientation will be held in two parts. Part 1 is a sit down presentation & part 2 will be training/tour for anyone interested in the Animal TLC program. Those who sign up for client care team or other volunteer positions will be free to leave after

	<p>part 1 which usually is around an hour & a half. Part 1 & 2 typically are completed in 2 hours base on the orientation size.</p>
Do I need to RSVP?	<p>RSVP is not required. Please come to the orientation that works best for you.</p>
What should I wear?	<p>Animal TLC Volunteers or if you are not sure at this time please wear close-toed shoes with good grip to orientation as we will be going into the kennel areas.</p>
Can my 8-12 year old child attend?	<p>Children 8-12 years old are welcome to attend orientation. Parents with children will serve as Animal TLC Volunteers and will be required to stay the entire 2 hours. You know your child best; please only have them attend if they are able to participate for the entire orientation & training.</p>
What should I bring?	<p>We kindly ask for a donation fee of \$25. We can accept cash, check, or credit. Paperwork will be provided, though you are welcome to print off the application & waiver from our website and bring it with you to orientation.</p>
