

Volunteering at LHS

Steps to volunteering	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Attend an adult orientation, no RSVP necessary.2) Choose an available volunteer program & attend required training3) Sign up for one shift a week for a 4 month volunteer session
Who can Volunteer	Adult volunteers must be 18+ and out of high school *Court-mandated community service cannot be fulfilled through our volunteer department. Please contact our Client Care Supervisors at 303-772-1232 ext. 222 instead
Average Start Time	We are very excited to have you join our team! The average length of time between attending orientation and your first volunteer shift can vary between a couple days to a couple months. The time frame varies on our training schedules & your availability, please be patient with us as we have many applications to process and volunteers to schedule after orientation.
Commitment	Though many volunteers stay with us for years, we ask that volunteers commit to a minimum of 4 months of service of one shift a week. Typical Animal TLC shifts include: Sunday-Saturday 8-10 a.m., 10-noon, noon-2 p.m., 2-4 p.m. or 4-6 p.m.
Donation Fee	We kindly ask for a \$25 contribution at orientation for a volunteer T-shirt and to help defray the cost of administering the volunteer program, which leaves more resources available for care of the animals.

Children Volunteers	<p>8-12 year olds can volunteer with a parent or legal guardian. We ask that no more than 2 children accompany an adult at one time.
