Where is the Orientation held?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Community Room at Longmont Humane Society (the classroom to the right of the intake desk).
How long is orientation?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Orientation is a combination of a classroom presentation and a tour of the shelter• This typically takes 1.5 to 2 hours
Do I need to RSVP?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• RSVP is not required for Adult Orientations; attend the date and time best for you
Can my 8-12 year old child attend?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Children aged 8-12 are welcome to attend orientation• Parent will serve as the primary volunteer.• You know your child best; please have them attend orientation with you only if they are able to participate for the entire orientation
Can my 13-18 year old child attend?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We have a very robust teen volunteer program. Teens aged 13-18 attend their own orientation dates and their own targeted training sessions. For more information about our Teen Volunteer program, please visit www.longmonthumane.org
