Orientation FAQ

Where is the Orientation held?	Orientations are held in the Community Room at Longmont Humane Society. This room is on the southeast corner of the building; enter through our Intake/Lost and Found doors.
How long is orientation?	Orientation is held in two parts: Part 1 is a sit down presentation and part 2 is a tour / training for anyone interested in the Animal TLC program. Those who sign up for Administrative, Clinic, Special Events, or other non-animal-handling volunteer positions will be free to leave after part 1, which usually lasts around 1 ½ hours. Parts 1 & 2 together are typically completed in 2 hours, depending on the orientation size.

<p>Do I need to RSVP?</p>	<p>RSVP is not required for Adult Orientations; please attend the date and time best for you.</p>
<p>What should I wear?</p>	<p>Clothes you aren't concerned about getting dirty; long shorts, capris, or full-length pants; please wear close-toed shoes with non-slip soles to orientation as we'll be going into kennel areas.</p>
<p>Can my 8-12 year old child attend?</p>	<p>Children aged 8-12 are welcome to attend orientation. Parents will serve as the primary Animal TLC Volunteers and will be required to stay the entire 2 hours. You know your child best; please have them attend orientation with you only if they are able to participate for the entire orientation and tour / training.</p>
<p>Can my 13-18 year old child attend?</p>	<p>We have a very robust teen volunteer program. Teens aged 13-18 attend their own orientation dates and their own targeted training sessions. For more information about our Teen Volunteer program, please visit www.longmonthumane.org</p>
<p>What should I bring?</p>	<p>We kindly ask for a donated tee-shirt fee of \$25; We accept cash, check, or credit cards – no AMEX. Paperwork will be provided, though you're welcome to print the application and waiver from our website to bring with you to orientation.</p>
